



**Bring Your Children and Entire Family to
THE 31st ANNUAL PLANETARY DANCE™**

Join **Anna Halprin and the Bay Area Community of Planetary Dancers** for this powerful dance for peace among people and peace with the Earth — which will be celebrated in countries around the world. This year's theme *Turning Point*, highlights the escalating urgency of the recent social and environmental crises. We will dance to create a unified voice strong, determined, and joyous enough to make a difference.

SCHEDULE – SATURDAY, JUNE 11, 2011

5:40 am—Sunrise: Greet the sun on the peak of Mt. Tamalpais with offerings of songs, poetry, prayers and stories. Then walk around the peak and be inspired by the spectacular beauty of the land. Arrive by 5:10 am and park at the last parking lot at the peak. It takes 45 minutes to get to this lot from the Stinson Beach exit off Highway 101. A walk to the peak takes another 15 minutes. Bring \$7 for the parking fee and a flashlight.

11:00 am—Main Event: Gather at Santos Meadow for an orientation with stories, songs and poetry. People of all ages and abilities can participate in the community dance that follows, in which individuals declare their commitment to a peaceful and healthy planet. As Anna Halprin describes, “When enough people move together in a common pulse with a common purpose, an amazing force, an ecstatic rhythm, eventually takes over... This is a power that can renew, inspire, teach, create and heal.” The dance ends with a Children's Run.

Potluck Celebration Party: After the dance, share food, relax, and play. This is a green event: please bring your own eating utensils, as well as food to share.

Special Guests: Along with Anna Halprin, Jamie McHugh will co-lead the dance. Presenters include Barbara Borden, Billy Cauley, Lucia Comnes, Fred Jackson, Jahan Khalighi, James Nixon, Annie Prutzman, and Jason Serinus.

Participation Details: People of all ages and abilities are welcome. The event will take place rain or shine. Please wear all black or white. Layered clothing is advised. The event is free. Suggested donation of \$10 to \$20 is appreciated to help cover costs. No one will be turned away for lack of funds.

Directions to Santos Meadow: Take Stinson Beach exit off Hwy 101. Follow signs to Hwy 1. Turn left at Tam Junction and follow Hwy 1 north. When road forks at park entrance, take lower road toward Muir and Stinson Beach. Turn right onto Muir Woods Rd., just north of the Pelican Inn. Look for colorful flags ½ mile on the left. (If you take the fork to Muir Woods, continue past Muir Woods until you see flags.) Please carpool as parking is limited.
